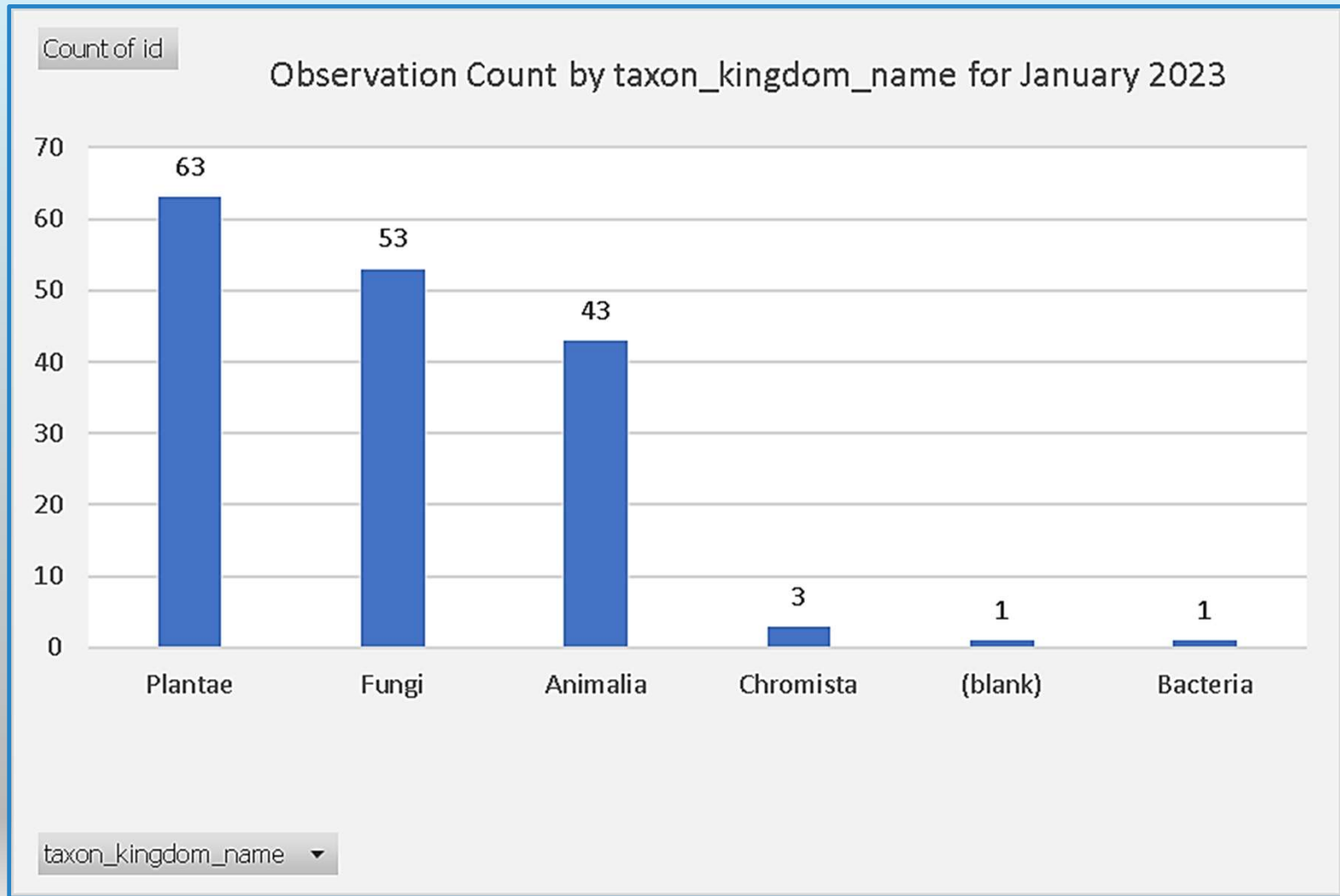

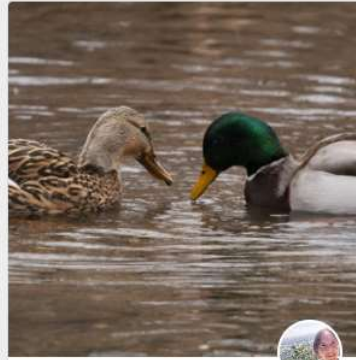


American Red Squirrel

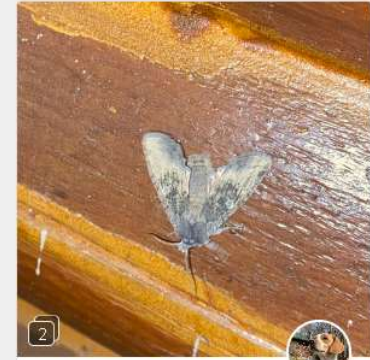


Dark-eyed Junco
